






















The Great Recession and Its Aftermath Altered the Structure of the Washington Area Economy




How is the Washington Area Economy Performing in Mid-2014?






15 Largest Job Markets Job Change: Jul 2013 – Jul 2014












Job Change by Sector Jul 2013 – Jul 2014 District of Columbia







Job Change by Sector Jul 2013 – Jul 2014 Suburban Maryland









Unemployment Rates in the WMSA By Sub-State Area, 2007-2014









Percent Change in Inventories of Existing Homes


Month-Over-Year 2000 – 2014, MSA








Total Listings Per Sale July Each Year








Median House Sales Price Washington MSA








Average Sales Price Percent Change Washington MSA All Housing Types








Average Sales Price Percent Change Northern Virginia All Housing Types








Washington MSA Building Permits







New Building Permits for Privately Owned Residential Units, WMSA






